



Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Precaution Guidelines Enacted

- ❑ **Healthfleet** is actively involved in implementing all practices and protocols for Infection Prevention and Control recommendations and will be working in cooperation with all Health Systems, Hospitals and Healthcare Facility Clients to ensure these prevention and control practices are being performed as required aspects of Standard Precautions.
- ❑ **Healthfleet** Staff will be required to provide notice of any flu-like symptoms and undergo a sign-in log to include recording of their body temperature at the beginning of every shift during this Prevention Guideline Notice Period until it is ended.
- ❑ **Healthfleet** and its Staff will be directed to ensure that environmental cleaning and disinfection procedures are followed consistently and correctly in preparing their vehicles and equipment, including stretchers, prior to any patient transport and following any patient transport after its complete before engaging in their next assignment and patient encounter.
- ❑ When COVID-19 is suspected in a patient needing emergency and non-emergency transport, prehospital and interhospital care providers and healthcare facilities should be notified in advance that they may be caring for, transporting, or receiving a patient who may have COVID-19 infection.
